About the MIT-Poland Lockheed Martin Seed Fund

MISTI Global Seed Funds, of which MIT-Poland is a part, enable participating teams to collaborate with international peers, either at MIT or abroad, with the aim of developing and launching joint research projects. All general MISTI Global Seed Funds criteria, application and evaluation procedures apply.

Through an annual call for proposals, the fund promotes the exchange between faculty and students at MIT and at universities and public research institutions in Poland. The maximum award is \$25,000.

Applications will open on September 13 and have a submission deadline of December 13, 2021.
