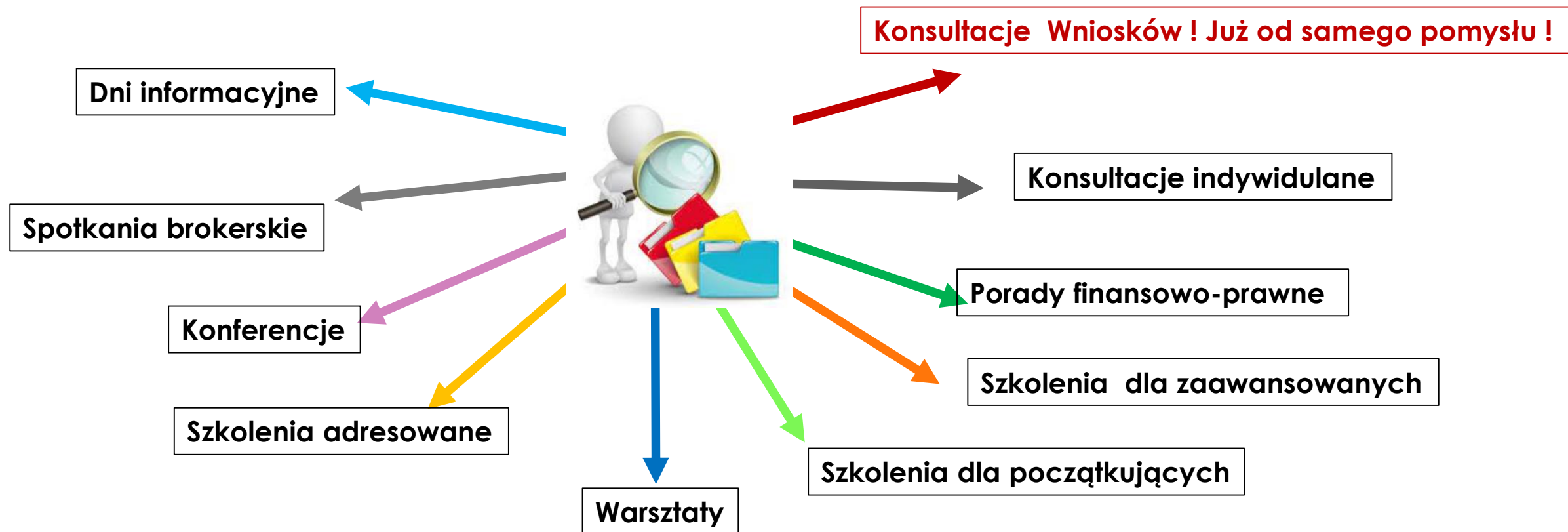


Kim jesteśmy? Agencja wykonawcza Ministra Edukacji i Nauki

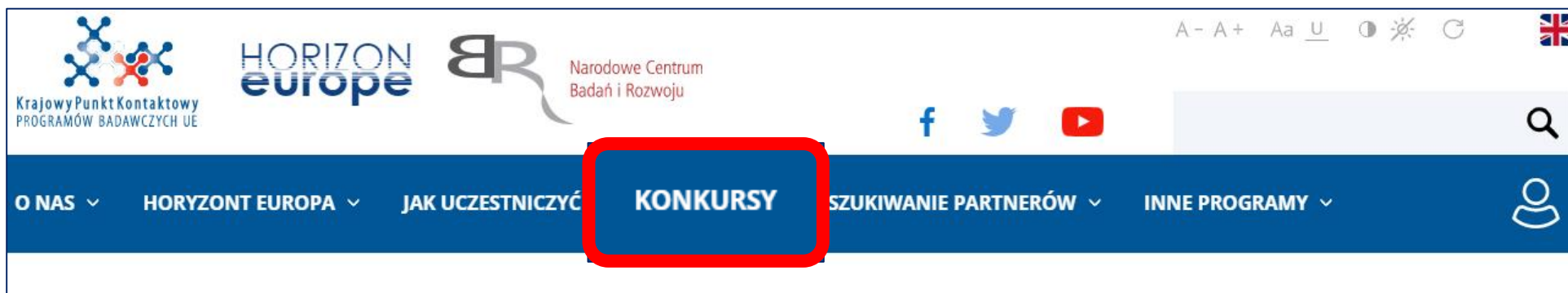

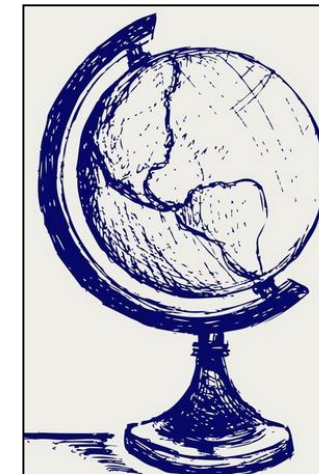

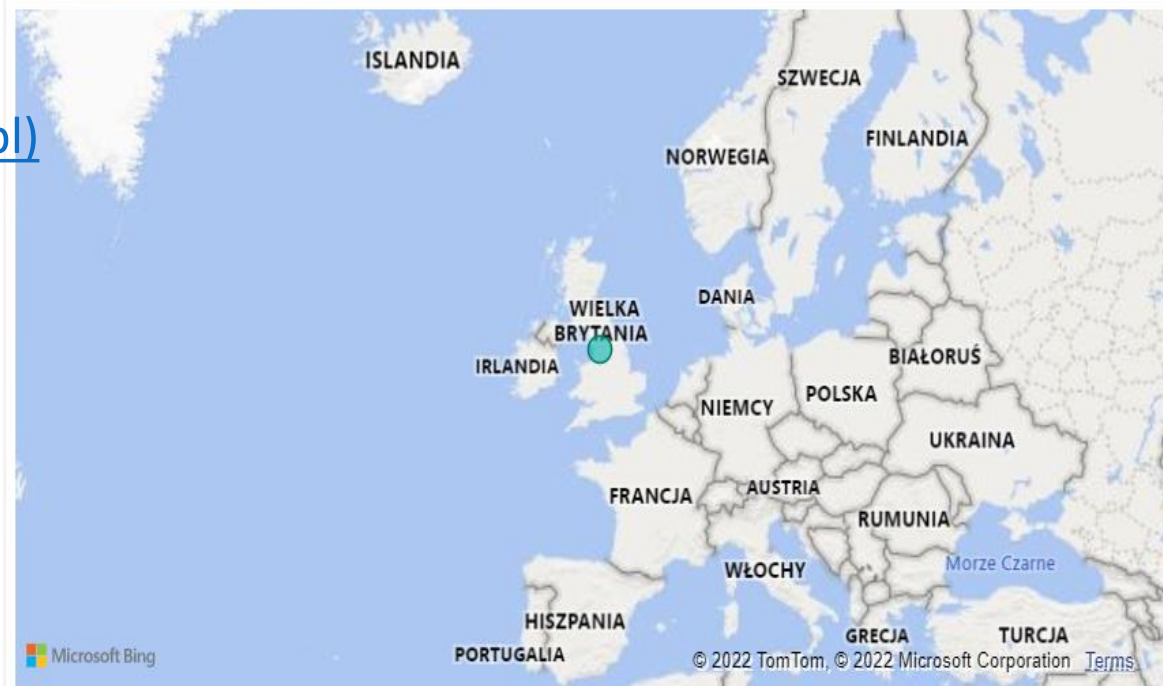

Dofin. NETTO [€] wg krajów

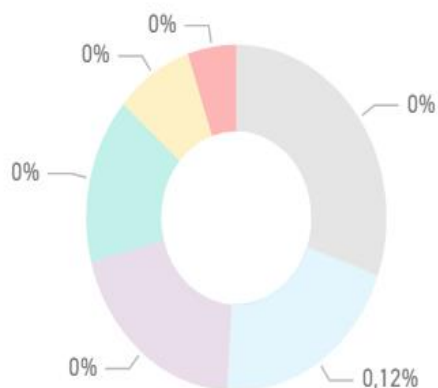


Dofin. NETTO [€] wg Filarów i Obszarów temat.

SME definition Small and medium-sized enterprises

Small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) represent 99% of all businesses in the EU. The definition of an SME is important for access to finance and EU support programmes targeted specifically at these enterprises.

What is an SME?

Small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) are defined in the [EU recommendation 2003/361](#).

The main factors determining whether an enterprise is an SME are

1. staff headcount
2. either turnover or balance sheet total

Company category	Staff headcount	Turnover	or	Balance sheet total
Medium-sized	< 250	≤ € 50 m		≤ € 43 m
Small	< 50	≤ € 10 m		≤ € 10 m
Micro	< 10	≤ € 2 m		≤ € 2 m

These ceilings apply to the figures for individual firms only. A firm that is part of a larger group may need to include staff headcount/turnover/balance sheet data from that group too.

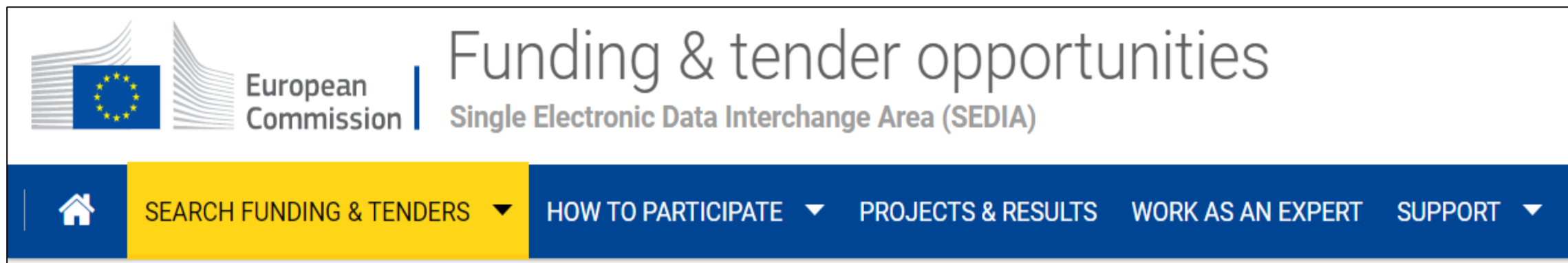

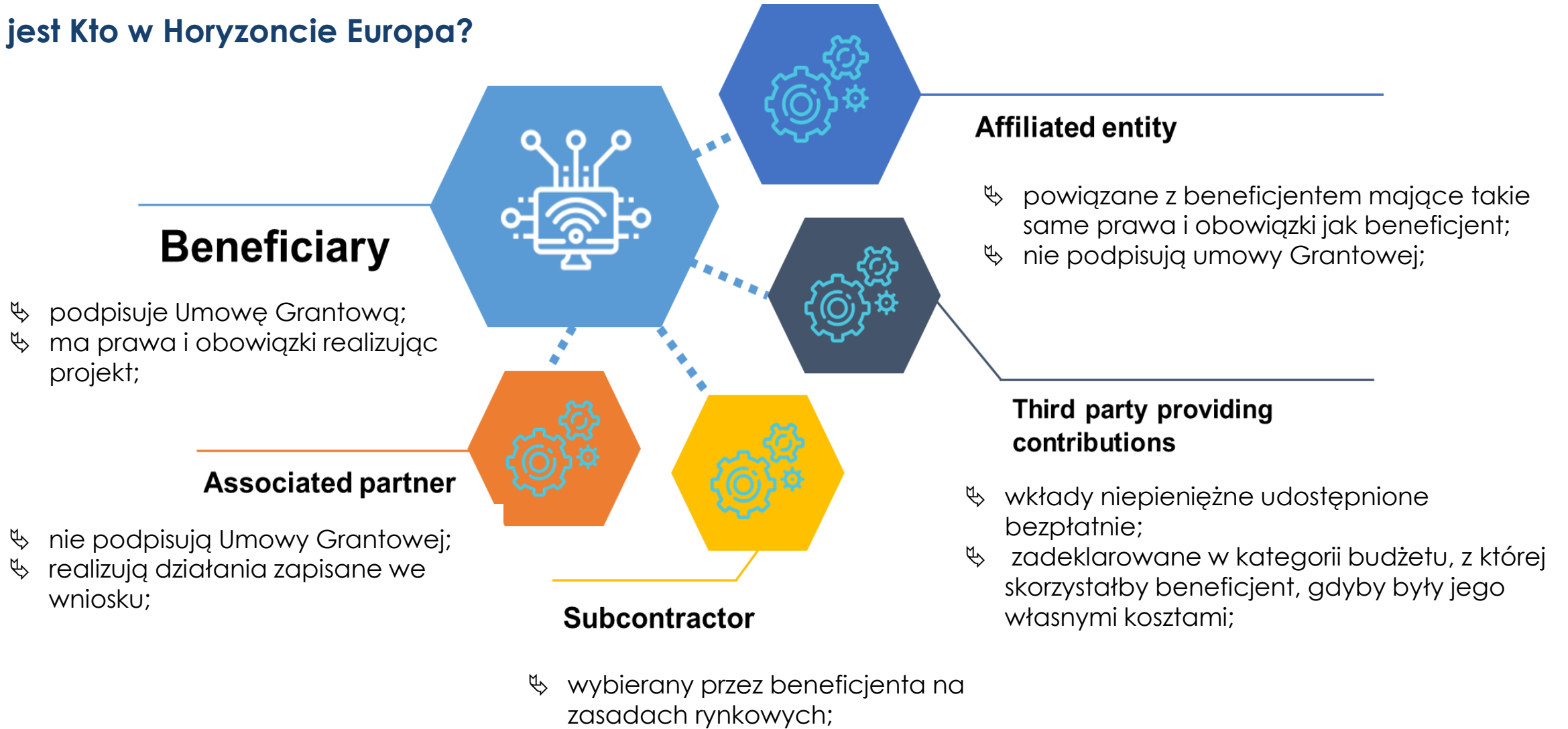

Basic rules of JRC involvement in the Horizon Europe calls...

JRC involvement in a proposal phase

In this phase, the JRC may not participate in drafting and submitting the project proposal. Similarly, the JRC may not join any applying consortium before the evaluation process is concluded.

If the applicants intend to involve the JRC in their project, they must envisage in their project proposal the JRC's possible contribution based on the information provided under the scope of the topic text. If information in the topic text is not sufficient, the applicant may search for additional information on the JRC's website or request specific information from the JRC directly...

JRC involvement once the proposal is selected for funding

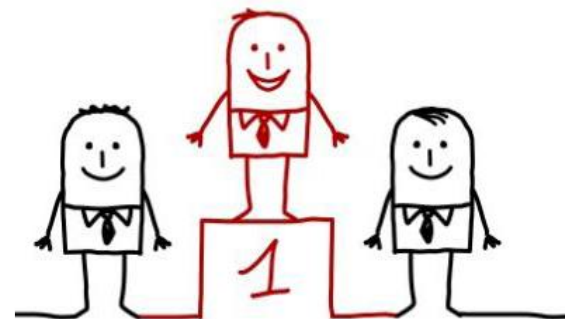
Only once the proposal is evaluated and selected for funding, the JRC and the winning consortia can enter into a deeper discussion on the specific terms of the JRC's participation in the project.

If an agreement is found, the JRC accedes the grant agreement as beneficiary requesting zero funding and becomes a member of the consortia. The JRC will enter into deeper discussions with all the consortia selected for funding in this particular topic, on the condition that the consortium had foreseen the possible JRC participation in its application.


If an agreement is not found, the JRC will not become a member of the consortium and the consortium can proceed with the project's implementation without the involvement of the JRC. This in practice means that the project will need to be feasible even without the JRC's possible contribution.
